Directions to Farmland Conservation Club:

The easiest way to get to Farmland Conservation club is to take SR 32 out of Muncie heading East. This will bring you to a stop sign / red flashing light at SR 1 in Farmland. Cross over SR 1 and head west on country road 200N for about 3 miles to 500w.

There will be a green and white sign for Farmland Conservation Club. Turn Right (South) on 500w and about a half mile you will go under some railroad tracks. Immediately after the tracks is the entrance to Farmland Conservation Club. Turn right and follow the road back to the club house.
